THE CATHEDRAL OF ALL SOULS  
FOOD BOOTH FUND GUIDELINES

1. The agency or organization should be doing God's work in the world, helping the kinds of people that Jesus was most concerned about – the homeless, the hungry, the young, the elderly, the poor and others who need help of some kind and are unable to get it on their own.
2. The agency or organization should not duplicate services which are adequately addressing peoples' needs.
3. The services of the agency or organization should be available to ALL persons in need.
4. The agency or organization should be governed by a board or body, which has demonstrated capable and responsible management. The members of the governing body should serve without compensation.
5. The agency or organization should demonstrate that it has a record of sound management and community service covering a reasonable period of time; or if it is a new organization, it should demonstrate that with convincing probability that it will establish such a record.
6. The organization or agency should be unable to support itself totally with funds from governmental bodies, endowment, fees and other incomes.
7. The agency or organization should be locally based, or one which operates primarily in Western North Carolina,
8. The agency or organization should be willing to list other contributors.
9. Projects with budgets under \$100,000 preferred; agencies with total budgets under \$500,000 preferred.
10. Innovative activity carried out primarily by volunteers preferred.
11. Grants in the past year ranged from 500 to 5,000 dollars.
12. Grants will be given at the 11:15 a.m. service on Sunday, October 18, 2009<sup>th</sup>. Awarded groups are invited to set up displays on church porch at 10:00 a.m. and also be present at displays after 11:15 a.m. service.
13. All groups who receive grants will report how monies were used no later than May 1, 2010.
