

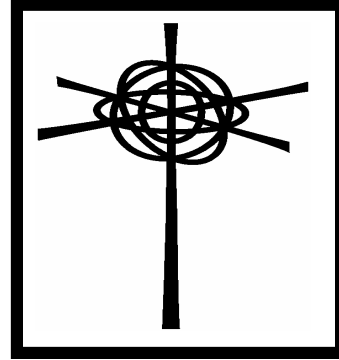

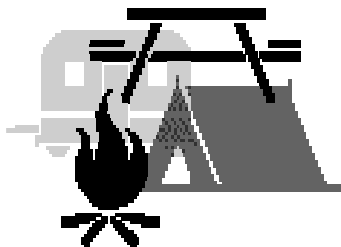

For instance, if a chorister wishes to sing the motet in September, then he or she comes to the allotted rehearsals for that particular piece.
